PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

International Study Tour

Today, Bellevue Hill PS welcomed visitors from Chengdu Longjiang Road Primary School in China who will be involved in a 6 day student tour of our school from Friday 8/2/19 - Friday 15/2/19.

There are 13 students accompanied by 4 teachers who will be engaging in lessons across the school, learning about our curriculum and our open classroom philosophy over In the coming week. As part of the tour, visiting teachers will familiarise themselves with the Inquiry learning model that underpins Bellevue Hill's conceptual units of work. Study tours such as these play are an important role in student learning, addressing the cross-curriculum priority Asia and Australia's engagement with Asia and enriching learning experiences. It provides an opportunity to celebrate diversity and develop knowledge and understanding of Asian societies, culture and environment. In addition, Intercultural Understanding, one of the Australian Curriculum's general capabilities adds richness and depth to our key learning areas.

BHPS is becoming recognised nationally and internationally for its teaching and learning programs in our innovative learning environments. Requests to visit our school from educational institutions, teachers and student tour groups across the globe are increasing and I relish in the opportunities these tours bring to the BHPS staff, students and extended community.

Our Chinese visitors will be officially welcomed and farewelled at our 3-6 Friday school assemblies and in two week's time we will be welcoming some Dutch Principals to our school.

Children who have failed to learn to read in the first few years of schooling need intensive, systematic reading instruction if they are not to fall further behind, or even become complete non-readers.

Parents, grandparents and friends of BHPS can volunteer as much or as little of their time to give one on one support to children who qualify for the program.

The Parent Tutor Program is an extremely valuable program in our school that supports students learning to read. It involves the school and our community working together to help our children achieve their potential.

Training will be supplied by the NSW Education Department at the school.

GO WITH THE FLOW (GWTF) RULES

We all want safety for our kids and to keep Go With The Flow going!

Please follow these rules:

ONLY THE FIRST 15 CARS in the queue are allowed to park, no double parking down Birriga Road as you will be booked! Please use the turning circle at the school, turn right onto Birriga and use the roundabout to then re-join the queue.

NO DOUBLE PARKING on either side of the slip road – offenders will be photographed. Police and rangers are patrolling the area both morning and afternoon.

NO PARENTS SHOULD BE GETTING OUT OF THEIR CAR in the GWTF line as this causes unnecessary delays. Please be courteous, considerate and use common sense when dropping off or picking up kids in GWTF.

SHOW APPRECIATION TO ALL OUR HELPERS with a simple smile and thank you, while they are assisting your children.

GIVE CARS ON THE RIGHT AND BEHIND YOU, RIGHT OF WAY when pulling off from the GWTF line.

BUSES HAVE RIGHT OF WAY before attempting to use the turning circle

PLEASE DO NOT SLIP INTO THE GWTF LINE UNLESS YOU SEE A LARGE ENOUGH SPACE to Park parallel with the pavement. (Many cars park at an angle which creates further congestion).

PLEASE PASS ON THIS INFORMATION to anyone picking up your children

If you have a number and don't already assist with GWTF your number will be cancelled in term 2 unless you give 2 dates you are able to assist.
