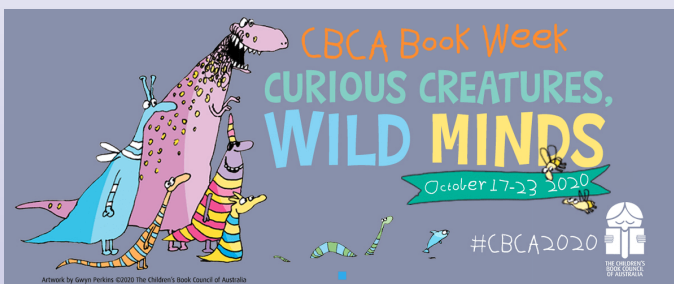
Curious Creatures Wild Minds Book Week 2020 19 - 23 October
