Why is BHPS participating in Scholastic Book Club?

The books offered span a wide range of children's reading levels and interests and are very reasonably priced.

Books in the catalogue can be ordered online ONLY through the Book Club LOOP platform for parents (Linked Online Ordering and Payment platform). Your order is electronically linked to BHPS, so that Scholastic will ship all orders to BHPS in a single bulk order for your teacher to distribute. Please do not fill out the ordering page at the back of each catalogue, as we are only accepting online orders. Orders must be placed by the specified date to ensure they are shipped to BHPS as part of our bulk order.

How Do I use LOOP?

You can access LOOP at **scholastic.com.au/ loop** or by using the LOOP app, which can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play.

- 1. Sign in or register an account.
- 2. Click on "ORDER" and select Bellevue Hill Public School and your child's class.
- 3. Add your child's first name and last initial (so the school knows who the book is for).
- 4. Enter the product item number from the Book Club Catalogue.
- 5. Make a payment via credit card.
- 6. All orders are delivered to your classroom teacher in a single delivery.

We love mistakes


This week in Year 1 we have been talking about how much we love mistakes!
