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

# Student attendance COVID Safety

All students are expected to be at school now unless they are unwell. Please do not send students to school if they are unwell, even with mild symptoms. Students with flu-like symptoms should get tested for COVID-19 and follow NSW Health directions. <u>Testing clinics</u>

If you your child has any COVID-19 symptoms whilst at school, they will be sent home and must not return to school unless they have either:

- isolated for 10 days, when no medical certificate is available, or,
- a negative COVID-19 test result and are symptom free (please send test results to school via email).

In circumstances where a student has other medical reasons for recurrent symptoms, a letter from your GP is sufficient to negate the requirement for a negative test.

#### **Sentral Parent Portal**

Please let the school know if your child is absent and provide the reason for their absence using the <u>Sentral Parent Portal</u>. Absences of 3 or more days must have a medical certificate which may be emailed to the school.



The Parent Portal application has many functions for communication between the home and the school that benefit parents and teachers. You can;

- view the school calendar,
- notify absences,
- view student reports,
- view school newsletters and receive notifications.

Thomas "I liked making the kites because I enjoy making origami so it's fun for me ".







# Maths learning in Year 3


#### **Using Money in Maths**














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# Year 4 Conceptual Immersion Day

Step 2: involved the DESIGN process of creating a top selling shoe!

This week Year 4 designed a shoe

that required students to research, analyse, think critically and work collaboratively.



The purpose of the <u>entrepreneurial</u> <u>inquiry</u> was to guide students into authentic and meaningful learning.



Step 1: was to devise a PLAN. They researched by gathering information and analysing what made particular shoes top sellers.



Step 3: required students to DEVELOP their shoe by detailing and personalising.



Step 4: DEPLOY - students marketed their shoe using persuasive advertising techniques.

### **LEGO Robotics in Year 5**

We have started a very exciting new project in Year 5 — Robotics! Working collaboratively, the students have been learning about the special components of the LEGO kits, how they work in unison together, how to build the robotic models and how to code them to get them moving.

We began with a robotic arm, progressed to a dancing robotic man and next up a bike!

We have even had students showing off their 'expertise' at a Genius Bar!

We have loved watching the effective teamwork which is being fostered between the groups, finding out what each person is capable of, and the sharing of new ideas, tips and tricks between small and large groups. Well done.


