## The best student of the community Russian School 2022


We are happy to let the Bellevue Hill Public School community know that our students thrive for their excellence in learning and outstanding behaviour outside our school.

We discussed what would be important to include in our design such as; fun rides, a café and a ticket booth. We then created a walk-around gallery, so that students could see each others designs.


We used sticky notes to leave positive feedback and kind words for each other.
